"I enjoy being an engineer because it's all about problem-solving. Even though we may encounter similar issues, the solutions are always different depending on the location, timing, and context. Since 2017, I have been looking after the facilities of this building. It may look like a normal residential building from the outside but there are actually six floors of facilities including function rooms, ballrooms, kitchens, a gym and even a daycare centre. My job involves doing regular check-ups of the electricity, water pumps, air-conditioning, lights and organising all necessary repairs. The role allows me to be analytical and to come up with creative ways to improve the environment. I also have access to all the facilities and 'hidden' machine rooms in the building - whether it be up on the roof or in the basement - which is why I'm always carrying a huge set of keys!"

"My colleagues and I work seamlessly as a team. When we encounter emergency issues, someone will always be on hand to help. We all step in when needed, even when we are off shift or it is in the middle of the night. I remember one time I was off work for Chinese New Year eve, when I was notified of a big emergency water issue on site. My home is in Tuen Mun but luckily at the time I was having dinner in Central, so I stepped in quickly to help resolve the issue. It would not have been ideal for our clients to not have access to water on the first day of Chinese New Year!"

"My team also works closely with the Jewish Community Centre, and we look after the facilities for their restaurant, kindergarten, synagogue, and other community spaces. I've learnt a lot about Jewish culture, rest days, and also certain religious rules and practices. The synagogue building is over a hundred years old so we also need to take special care of it. It is always interesting to work with clients from diverse backgrounds and cultures and learn how best to accommodate their needs. As an engineer, you don't know what sorts of issues you'll encounter on any given day - so every day is a new experience!"

"我喜歡當一位工程師，因為此職位容許我解決不同的問題。即使我們間中會遇到接近的問題，但解決的方案往往會因為地點、時間和情境而有所不同。由2017年開始，我便在這裡負責看管大廈的設施。這幢大廈的外表看起來可能像一幢普通的住宅，但其實這裡有六層的設施，包括會議廳、宴會廳、廚房、健身房，甚至還有一個日間托服務中心。我的工作包括定期檢查電力、水泵、冷氣系統、照明以及安排所有維修工作。這個崗位讓我可以分析不同的問題，並想出具創意的方案來改善環境。不論是在天台還是在地庫，我還可以進出大廈裡的所有設施和「隱藏」的電機房，這就是我總是帶著一大串鑰匙的原因！"

"我和我的同事們可說是合作無間。每當我們遇到緊急事故的時候，總會有人準備好提供協助。不論是已經換班或是夜深，我們大家都會在有需要的情況下提供支援。我還記得有一個年三十晚，我在下班後得知大廈出現了緊急水務問題。我住在屯門，但幸好那時候我正在中環吃晚餐，所以我可以很快趕到現場協助。畢竟大年初一沒有水，對客戶來說就真的很麻煩！"

"我的團隊也會跟猶太社區中心緊密合作，我們負責看管他們的餐廳、幼兒園、猶太教堂以及其他社區空間內的設施。透過工作，我學到了很多跟猶太人有關的事情，例如是他們的文化、休息日以及特定的宗教規矩和習慣。這裡的猶太教堂已經有超過一百年的歷史，所以我們都要特別小心維護它。與來自不同背景和文化的客人合作，並學習如何配合他們的需求都是很有趣的經驗。作為一名工程師，你永遠不會知道每一天會遇到怎樣的難題，所以幾乎每天都是新體驗！"
